- 1. And he said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself." Genesis 3:10
- 2. The fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth and upon every bird of the heavens, upon everything that creeps on the ground and all the fish of the sea. Into your hand they are delivered. Genesis 9:2
- 3. After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." Genesis 15:1
- 4. And God heard the voice of the boy, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, "What troubles you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the boy where he is. Genesis 21:17
- 5. He said, "Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me." Genesis 22:12
- 6. And the LORD appeared to him the same night and said, "I am the God of Abraham your father. Fear not, for I am with you and will bless you and multiply your offspring for my servant Abraham's sake." Genesis 26:24
- 7. If the God of my father, the God of Abraham and the Fear of Isaac, had not been on my side, surely now you would have sent me away empty-handed. God saw my affliction and the labor of my hands and rebuked you last night." Genesis 31:42
- 8. On the third day Joseph said to them, "Do this and you will live, for I fear God Genesis 42:18
- 9. He replied, "Peace to you, do not be afraid. Your God and the God of your father has put treasure in your sacks for you. I received your money." Then he brought Simeon out to them. Genesis 43:23
- 10. Then he said, "I am God, the God of your father. Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for there I will make you into a great nation. Genesis 46:3
- 11. But Joseph said to them, "Do not fear, for am I in the place of God? Genesis 50:19
- 12. So do not fear; I will provide for you and your little ones." Thus he comforted them and spoke kindly to them. Genesis 50:21
- 13. But as for you and your servants, I know that you do not yet fear the LORD God." Exodus 9:30
- 14. And Moses said to the people, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. Exodus 14:13
- 15. Moreover, look for able men from all the people, men who fear God, who are trustworthy and hate a bribe, and place such men over the people as chiefs of thousands, of hundreds, of fifties, and of tens. Exodus 18:21

- 19. You shall not wrong one another, but you shall fear your God, for I am the LORD your God. Leviticus 25:17
- 20. Take no interest from him or profit, but fear your God, that your brother may live beside you. Leviticus 25:36
- 21. You shall not rule over him ruthlessly but shall fear your God. Leviticus 25:43

- 22. Only do not rebel against the LORD. And do not fear the people of the land, for they are bread for us. Their protection is removed from them, and the LORD is with us; do not fear them." Numbers 14:9
- 23. But the LORD said to Moses, "Do not fear him, for I have given him into your hand, and all his people, and his land. And you shall do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who lived at Heshbon." Numbers 21:34
- 24. See, the LORD your God has set the land before you. Go up, take possession, as the LORD, the God of your fathers, has told you. Do not fear or be dismayed.' Deuteronomy 1:21
- 25. Then I said to you, 'Do not be in dread or afraid of them. Deuteronomy 1:29

- 27. You shall not fear them, for it is the LORD your God who fights for you.' Deuteronomy 3:22
- 28. how on the day that you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, the LORD said to me, 'Gather the people to me, that I may let them hear my words, so that they may learn to fear me all the days that they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children so.' Deuteronomy 4:10
- 29. Oh that they had such a heart as this always, to fear me and to keep all my commandments, that it might go well with them and with their descendants forever! Deuteronomy 5:29
- 30. that you may fear the LORD your God, you and your son and your son's son, by keeping all his statutes and his commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be long. Deuteronomy 6:2
- 31. It is the LORD your God you shall fear. Him you shall serve and by his name you shall swear. Deuteronomy 6:13
- 32. And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as we are this day. Deuteronomy 6:24
- 33. You shall not be in dread of them, for the Lord your God is in your midst, a great and awesome God. Deuteronomy 7:24
- 34. So you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God by walking in his ways and by fearing him. Deuteronomy 8:6
- 35. And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, Deuteronomy 10:12
- 36. You shall fear the LORD your God. You shall serve him and hold fast to him, and by his name you shall swear. Deuteronomy 10:20
- 37. You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him. Deuteronomy 13:4
- 38. And all Israel shall hear and fear and never again do any such wickedness as this among you. Deuteronomy 13:11
- 39. And before the LORD your God, in the place that he will choose, to make his name dwell there, you shall eat the tithe of your grain, of your wine, and of your oil, and the firstborn of your herd and flock, that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always. Deuteronomy 14:23
- 40. And all the people shall hear and fear and not act presumptuously again. Deuteronomy 17:13
- 41. And it shall be with him, and he shall read in it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God by keeping all the words of this law and these statutes, and doing them, Deuteronomy 17:19
- 42. and shall say to them, 'Hear, O Israel, today you are drawing near for battle against your enemies: let not your heart faint. Do not fear or panic or be in dread of them, Deuteronomy 20:3

- 43. If you are not careful to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, the LORD your God, Deuteronomy 28:58
- 44. Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you." Deuteronomy 31:6
- 45. It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." Deuteronomy 31:8
- 46. Assemble the people, men, women, and little ones, and the sojourner within your towns, that they may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God, and be careful to do all the words of this law, Deuteronomy 31:12
- 47. and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as you live in the land that you are going over the Jordan to possess." Deuteronomy 31:13
- 48. They sacrificed to demons that were no gods, to gods they had never known, to new gods that had come recently, whom your fathers had never dreaded. Deuteronomy 32:17
- 49. so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the LORD is mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever." Joshua 4:24

- 54. "Now therefore fear the LORD and serve him in sincerity and in faithfulness. Put away the gods that your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD. Joshua 24:14
- 55. And I said to you, 'I am the LORD your God; you shall not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.' But you have not obeyed my voice." Judges 6:10

- 61. Only fear the LORD and serve him faithfully with all your heart. For consider what great things he has done for you. 1 Samuel 12:24
- 62. Stay with me; do not be afraid, for he who seeks my life seeks your life. With me you shall be in safekeeping." 1 Samuel 22:23
- 63. And he said to him, "Do not fear, for the hand of Saul my father shall not find you. You shall be king over Israel, and I shall be next to you. Saul my father also knows this." 1 Samuel 23:17

- 64. And David said to him, "Do not fear, for I will show you kindness for the sake of your father Jonathan, and I will restore to you all the land of Saul your father, and you shall eat at my table always." 2 Samuel 9:7
- 65. The God of Israel has spoken; the Rock of Israel has said to me: When one rules justly over men, ruling in the fear of God, 2 Samuel 23:3
- 66. that they may fear you all the days that they live in the land that you gave to our fathers. 1 Kings 8:40
- 67. hear in heaven your dwelling place and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to you, in order that all the peoples of the earth may know your name and fear you, as do your people Israel, and that they may know that this house that I have built is called by your name. 1 Kings 8:43
- 68. And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said. But first make me a little cake of it and bring it to me, and afterward make something for yourself and your son. 1 Kings 17:13
- 69. And as soon as I have gone from you, the Spirit of the LORD will carry you I know not where. And so, when I come and tell Ahab and he cannot find you, he will kill me, although I your servant have feared the LORD from my youth. 1 Kings 18:12
- 70. Then the angel of the LORD said to Elijah, "Go down with him; do not be afraid of him." So he arose and went down with him to the king 2 Kings 1:15
- 71. Now the wife of one of the sons of the prophets cried to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the LORD, but the creditor has come to take my two children to be his slaves." 2 Kings 4:1
- 72. He said, "Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." 2 Kings 6:16
- 73. So one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and lived in Bethel and taught them how they should fear the LORD. 2 Kings 17:28
- 74. To this day they do according to the former manner. They do not fear the LORD, and they do not follow the statutes or the rules or the law or the commandment that the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel. 2 Kings 17:34
- 75. The LORD made a covenant with them and commanded them, "You shall not fear other gods or bow yourselves to them or serve them or sacrifice to them, 2 Kings 17:35
- 76. but you shall fear the LORD, who brought you out of the land of Egypt with great power and with an outstretched arm. You shall bow yourselves to him, and to him you shall sacrifice. 2 Kings 17:36
- 77. And the statutes and the rules and the law and the commandment that he wrote for you, you shall always be careful to do. You shall not fear other gods, 2 Kings 17:37
- 78. but you shall fear the LORD your God, and he will deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies." 2 Kings 17:39
- 79. Isaiah said to them, "Say to your master, 'Thus says the LORD: Do not be afraid because of the words that you have heard, with which the servants of the king of Assyria have reviled me. 2 Kings 19:6
- 80. And Gedaliah swore to them and their men, saying, "Do not be afraid because of the Chaldean officials. Live in the land and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you." 2 Kings 25:24
- 81. tremble before him, all the earth; yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved. 1 Chronicles 16:30
- 82. Then you will prosper if you are careful to observe the statutes and the rules that the LORD commanded Moses for Israel. Be strong and courageous. Fear not; do not be dismayed. 1 Chronicles 22:13

- 83. Then David said to Solomon his son, "Be strong and courageous and do it. Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed, for the LORD God, even my God, is with you. He will not leave you or forsake you, until all the work for the service of the house of the LORD is finished. 1 Chronicles 28:20
- 84. that they may fear you and walk in your ways all the days that they live in the land that you gave to our fathers. 2 Chronicles 6:31
- 85. And they attacked all the cities around Gerar, for the fear of the LORD was upon them. They plundered all the cities, for there was much plunder in them. 2 Chronicles 14:14
- 86. And the fear of the LORD fell upon all the kingdoms of the lands that were around Judah, and they made no war against Jehoshaphat. 2 Chronicles 17:10
- 87. Now then, let the fear of the LORD be upon you. Be careful what you do, for there is no injustice with the LORD our God, or partiality or taking bribes." 2 Chronicles 19:7
- 88. And he charged them: "Thus you shall do in the fear of the LORD, in faithfulness, and with your whole heart: 2 Chronicles 19:9
- 89. And he said, "Listen, all Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem and Kings Jehoshaphat: Thus says the LORD to you, 'Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed at this great horde, for the battle is not yours but God's. 2 Chronicles 20:15

- 186. I perceived that whatever God does endures forever; nothing can be added to it, nor anything taken from it. God has done it, so that people fear before him. Ecclesiastes 3:14
- 187. For when dreams increase and words grow many, there is vanity; but God is the one you must fear. Ecclesiastes 5:7
- 188. For he will not much remember the days of his life because God keeps him occupied with joy in his heart. Ecclesiastes 5:20
- 189. Though a sinner does evil a hundred times and prolongs his life, yet I know that it will be well with those who fear God, because they fear before him. Ecclesiastes 8:12
- 190. So refuse to worry, and keep your body healthy. But remember that youth, with a whole life before you, is meaningless. Ecclesiastes 11:10
- 191. The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13
- 192. Enter into the rock and hide in the dust from before the terror of the Lord , and from the splendor of his majesty. Isaiah 2:10
- 193. And people shall enter the caves of the rocks and the holes of the ground, from before the terror of the Lord, and from the splendor of his majesty, when he rises to terrify the earth. Isaiah 2:19
- 194. to enter the caverns of the rocks and the clefts of the cliffs, from before the terror of the Lord, and from the splendor of his majesty, when he rises to terrify the earth. Isaiah 2:21

- 195. And say to him, 'Be careful, be quiet, do not fear, and do not let your heart be faint because of these two smoldering stumps of firebrands, at the fierce anger of Rezin and Syria and the son of Remaliah. Isaiah 7:4
- 196. "Do not call conspiracy all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor be in dread. Isaiah 8:12
- 197. But the Lord of hosts, him you shall honor as holy. Let him be your fear, and let him be your dread. Isaiah 8:13
- 198. And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord Isaiah. 11:2
- 199. And his delight shall be in the fear of the Lord . He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what his ears hear, Isaiah 11:3
- 200. In that day the Egyptians will be like women, and tremble with fear before the hand that the Lord of hosts shakes over them. Isaiah 19:16
- 201. Therefore strong peoples will glorify you; cities of ruthless nations will fear you. Isaiah 25:3
- 202. And the Lord said: "Because this people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men, Isaiah 29:13
- 203. For when he sees his children, the work of my hands, in his midst, they will sanctify my name; they will sanctify the Holy One of Jacob and will stand in awe of the God of Israel. Isaiah 29:23
- 204. and he will be the stability of your times, abundance of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge; the fear of the Lord is Zion's treasure. Isaiah 33:6
- 205. Isaiah said to them, "Say to your master, 'Thus says the LORD: Do not be afraid because of the words that you have heard, with which the young men of the king of Assyria have reviled me. Isaiah 37:6
- 206. Go on up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of good news; lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, herald of good news; lift it up, fear not; say to the cities of Judah, "Behold your God!" Isaiah 40:9
- 207. fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. Isaiah 41:10
- 208. For I, the LORD your God, hold your right hand; it is I who say to you, "Fear not, I am the one who helps you." Isaiah 41:13
- 209. Fear not, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel! I am the one who helps you, declares the LORD; your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 41:14

- 221. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the LORD." Jeremiah 1:8
- 222. Your evil will chastise you, and your apostasy will reprove you. Know and see that it is evil and bitter for you to forsake the Lord your God; the fear of me is not in you, declares the Lord God of hosts. Jeremiah 2:19
- 223. My anguish, my anguish! I writhe in pain! Oh the walls of my heart! My heart is beating wildly; I cannot keep silent, for I hear the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war. Jeremiah 4:19

- 244. and the chief of the eunuchs said to Daniel, "I fear my lord the king, who assigned your food and your drink; for why should he see that you were in worse condition than the youths who are of your own age? So you would endanger my head with the king." Daniel 1:10
- 245. And the king said to them, "I had a dream, and my spirit is troubled to know the dream." Daniel 2:3
- 246. I make a decree, that in all my royal dominion people are to tremble and fear before the God of Daniel, for he is the living God, enduring forever; his kingdom shall never be destroyed, and his dominion shall be to the end. Daniel 6:26
- 247. As for me, Daniel, my spirit within me was anxious, and the visions of my head alarmed me. Daniel 7:15
- 248. Then he said to me, "Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words. Daniel 10:12
- 249. And he said, "O man greatly loved, fear not, peace be with you; be strong and of good courage." And as he spoke to me, I was strengthened and said, "Let my lord speak, for you have strengthened me." Daniel 10:19
- 250. Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the Lord their God, and David their king, and they shall come in fear to the Lord and to his goodness in the latter days. Hosea 3:5
- 251. For now they will say: "We have no king, for we do not fear the LORD; and a king--what could he do for us?" Hosea 10:3
- 252. "Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice, for the LORD has done great things! Joel 2:21
- 253. Fear not, you beasts of the field, for the pastures of the wilderness are green; the tree bears its fruit; the fig tree and vine give their full yield. Joel 2:22
- $254.\;$ And he said to them, "I am a Hebrew, and I fear the Lord , the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land." Jonah 1:9

- 255. they shall lick the dust like a serpent, like the crawling things of the earth; they shall come trembling out of their strongholds; they shall turn in dread to the Lord our God, and they shall be in fear of you. Micah 7:17
- 256. I said, 'Surely you will fear me; you will accept correction. Then your dwelling would not be cut off according to all that I have appointed against you.' But all the more they were eager to make all their deeds corrupt. Zephaniah 3:7
- 257. On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Fear not, O Zion; let not your hands grow weak. Zephaniah 3:16
- 258. Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the Lord their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the Lord their God had sent him. And the people feared the Lord. Haggai 1:12
- 259. according to the covenant that I made with you when you came out of Egypt. My Spirit remains in your midst. Fear not. Haggai 2:5
- 260. And as you have been a byword of cursing among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, so will I save you, and you shall be a blessing. Fear not, but let your hands be strong."

 Zechariah 8:13
- 261. so again have I purposed in these days to bring good to Jerusalem and to the house of Judah; fear not. Zechariah 8:15
- 262. "A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am a father, where is my honor? And if I am a master, where is my fear? says the Lord of hosts to you, O priests, who despise my name. But you say, 'How have we despised your name?' Malachi 1:6
- 263. My covenant with him was one of life and peace, and I gave them to him. It was a covenant of fear, and he feared me. He stood in awe of my name. Malachi 2:5

- 284. But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. Luke 1:13
- 285. And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Luke 1:30
- 286. And his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation. Luke 1:50
- 287. that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve him without fear, Luke 1:74
- 288. And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Luke 2:10
- 289. and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." Luke 5:10
- 290. And amazement seized them all, and they glorified God and were filled with awe, saying, "We have seen extraordinary things today." Luke 5:26
- 291. "And why worry about a speck in your friend's eye when you have a log in your own? Luke 6:41

- 295. But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, Luke 10:41
- 296. "I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do. Luke 12:4
- 297. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him! Luke 12:5
- 298. Why, even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not; you are of more value than many sparrows. Luke 12:7
- 299. Luke 12:11 And when they bring you before the synagogues and the rulers and the authorities, do not be anxious about how you should defend yourself or what you should say,

- 300. And he said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on. Luke 12:22
- 301. And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? Luke 12:25
- 302. If then you are not able to do as small a thing as that, why are you anxious about the rest? Luke 12:26
- 303. "Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Luke 12:32
- 304. people fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world. For the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Luke 21:26
- 305. But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? Luke 23:40
- 306. But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. Luke 24:37
- 307. And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Luke 24:38
- 308. But he said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." John 6:20
- 309. "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!" John 12:15
- 310. After saying these things, Jesus was troubled in his spirit, and testified, "Truly, truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me." John 13:21
- 311. "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me." John 14:1
- 312. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. John 14:27
- 313. I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." John 16:33
- 314. On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." John 20:19
- 315. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. Acts 2:43
- 316. When Ananias heard these words, he fell down and breathed his last. And great fear came upon all who heard of it. Acts 5:5
- 317. And great fear came upon the whole church and upon all who heard of these things. Acts 5:11
- 318. So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied. Acts 9:31
- 319. And they said, "Cornelius, a centurion, an upright and God-fearing man, who is well spoken of by the whole Jewish nation, was directed by a holy angel to send for you to come to his house and to hear what you have to say." Acts 10:22

- 323. No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God, Romans 4:20
- 324. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" Romans 8:15
- 325. That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand fast through faith. So do not become proud, but fear. Romans 11:20

- 326. For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, Romans 13:3
- 327. for he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain. For he is the servant of God, an avenger who carries out God's wrath on the wrongdoer. Romans 13:4
- 328. Pay to all what is owed to them: taxes to whom taxes are owed, revenue to whom revenue is owed, respect to whom respect is owed, honor to whom honor is owed. Romans 13:7
- 329. And I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling, 1 Corinthians 2:3
- 330. I want you to be free from anxieties. The unmarried man is anxious about the things of the Lord, how to please the Lord. 1 Corinthians 7:32
- 331. But the married man is anxious about worldly things, how to please his wife, 1 Corinthians 7:33
- 332. and his interests are divided. And the unmarried or betrothed woman is anxious about the things of the Lord, how to be holy in body and spirit. But the married woman is anxious about worldly things, how to please her husband. 1 Corinthians 7:34
- 333. Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God. 2 Corinthians 7:1
- 334. For even when we came into Macedonia, our bodies had no rest, but we were afflicted at every turn—fighting without and fear within. 2 Corinthians 7:5
- 335. For see what earnestness this godly grief has produced in you, but also what eagerness to clear yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what longing, what zeal, what punishment! At every point you have proved yourselves innocent in the matter. 2 Corinthians 7:11
- 336. And his affection for you is even greater, as he remembers the obedience of you all, how you received him with fear and trembling. 2 Corinthians 7:15
- 337. But I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ. 2 Corinthians 11:3
- 338. For I fear that perhaps when I come I may find you not as I wish, and that you may find me not as you wish—that perhaps there may be quarreling, jealousy, anger, hostility, slander, gossip, conceit, and disorder. 2 Corinthians 12:20
- 339. I fear that when I come again my God may humble me before you, and I may have to mourn over many of those who sinned earlier and have not repented of the impurity, sexual immorality, and sensuality that they have practiced. 2 Corinthians 12:21
- 340. For before certain men came from James, he was eating with the Gentiles; but when they came he drew back and separated himself, fearing the circumcision party. Galatians 2:12
- 341. submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ. Ephesians 5:21
- 342. And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear. Philippians 1:14
- 343. Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, Philippians 2:12
- 344. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. Philippians 4:6
- 345. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:7
- 346. Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eyeservice, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. Colossians 3:22
- 347. As for those who persist in sin, rebuke them in the presence of all, so that the rest may stand in fear. 1 Timothy 5:20
- 348. for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control. 2 Timothy 1:7

- 349. and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery. Hebrews 2:15
- 350. Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. Hebrews 3:12
- 351. Therefore, while the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us fear lest any of you should seem to have failed to reach it. Hebrews 4:1
- 352. By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith. Hebrews 11:7
- 353. Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I tremble with fear." Hebrews 12:21
- 354. Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, Hebrews 12:28
- 355. So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" Hebrews 13:6
- 356. And if you call on him as Father who judges impartially according to each one's deeds, conduct yourselves with fear throughout the time of your exile, 1 Peter 1:17
- 357. Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor. 1 Peter 2:17
- 358. Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect, not only to the good and gentle but also to the unjust. 1 Peter 2:18
- 359. when they see your respectful and pure conduct. 1 Peter 3:2
- 360. as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord. And you are her children, if you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening. 1Pe 3:6
- 361. But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, 1 Peter 3:14
- 362. casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7
- 363. and if he rescued righteous Lot, greatly distressed by the sensual conduct of the wicked 2 Peter 2:7
- 364. (for as that righteous man lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard); 2 Peter 2:8
- 365. save others by snatching them out of the fire; to others show mercy with fear, hating even the garment stained by the flesh. Jude 1:23
- 366. When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last, Revelation 1:17
- 367. Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life. Revelation 2:10
- 368. But after the three and a half days a breath of life from God entered them, and they stood up on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. Revelation 11:11
- 369. The nations raged, but your wrath came, and the time for the dead to be judged, and for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying the destroyers of the earth." Revelation 11:18
- 370. And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

 Revelation 14:7
- 371. Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed." Revelation 15:4
- 372. They will stand far off, in fear of her torment, and say, "Alas! Alas! You great city, you mighty city, Babylon! For in a single hour your judgment has come." Revelation 18:10

- 373. The merchants of these wares, who gained wealth from her, will stand far off, in fear of her torment, weeping and mourning aloud, Revelation 18:15
- 374. And from the throne came a voice saying, "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, small and great." Revelation 19:5
